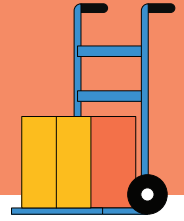


Generosity is making someone's day by giving something away.

Read: James 1:17a

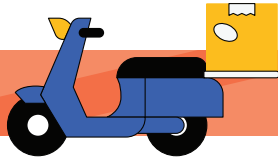


DAY

LOOK around at what God has given you.

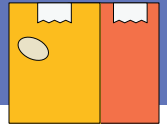

Always Give

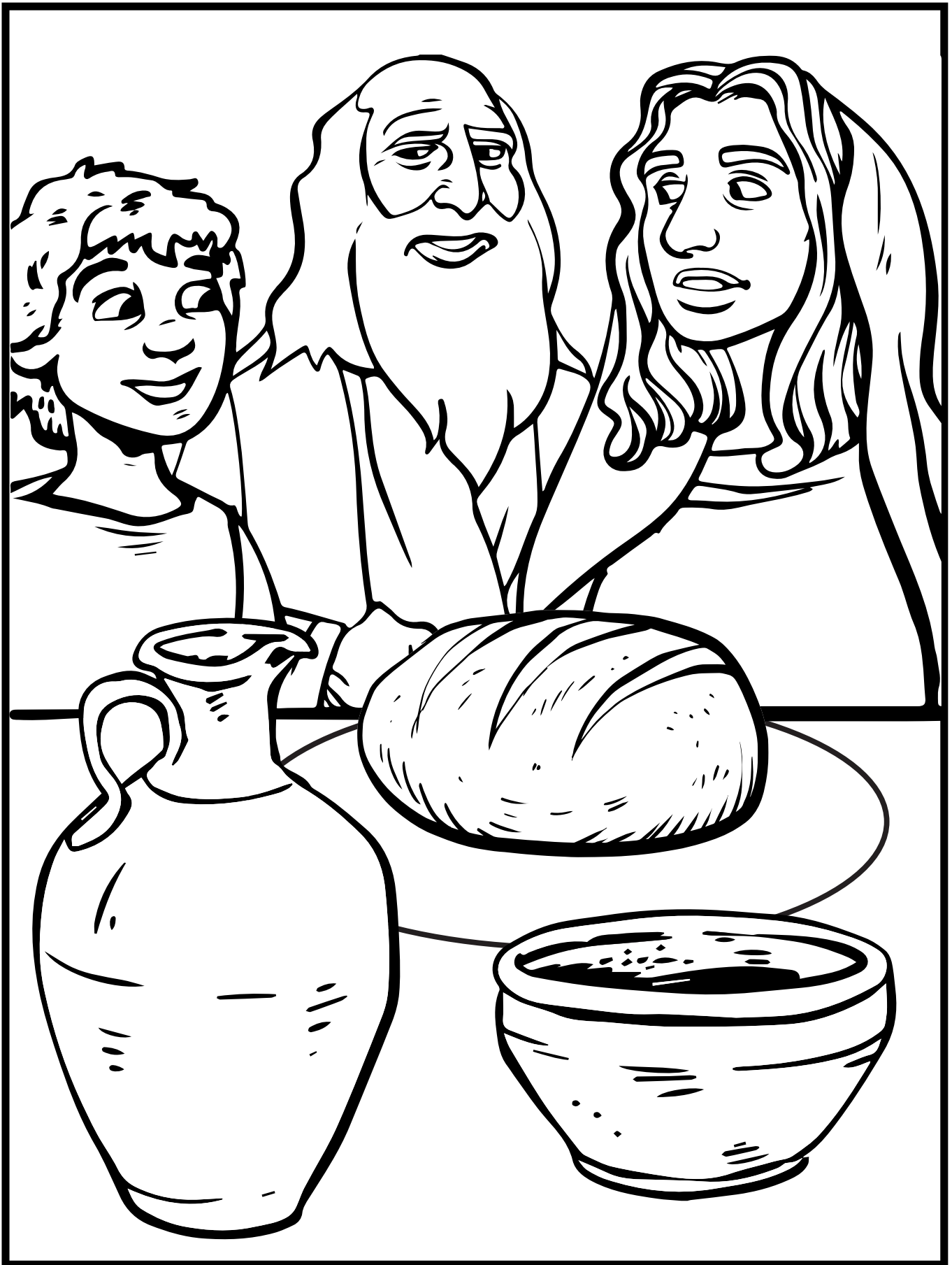
We always have something to give. Say a prayer asking God to help you see others.

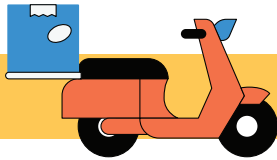

KNOW that you can help others too!

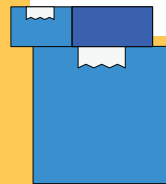

THANK God for giving us more than we need so that we can share.

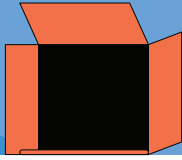

LOOK for ways to show up for those around you today.

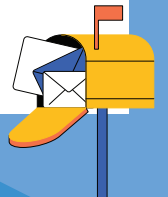

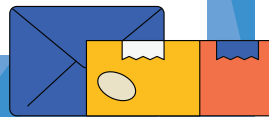
