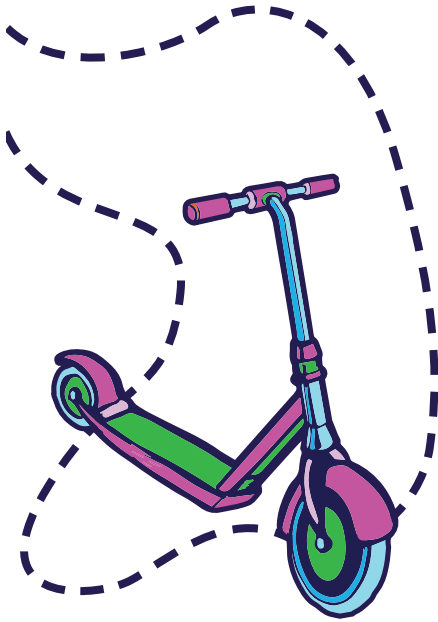

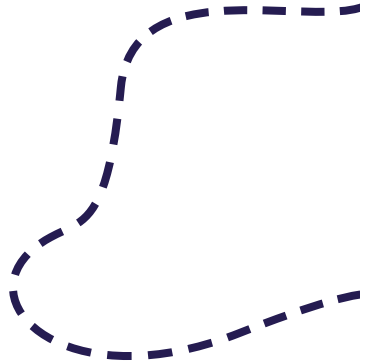


Bible Story

Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Jesus loves you so much, and He wants to be your friend forever."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You for sending Jesus to be our friend forever."



Drive Time

While on the go, look for lights. Talk about how Jesus used a very bright light to make Paul stop and listen to Him. Jesus wanted Paul to be His friend forever.



Bath Time

As you bathe your child, sing the following words to the tune of "The Wheels on the Bus": "Jesus wants to be my friend forever, friend forever, friend forever. Jesus wants to be my friend forever. For ever and ever!"

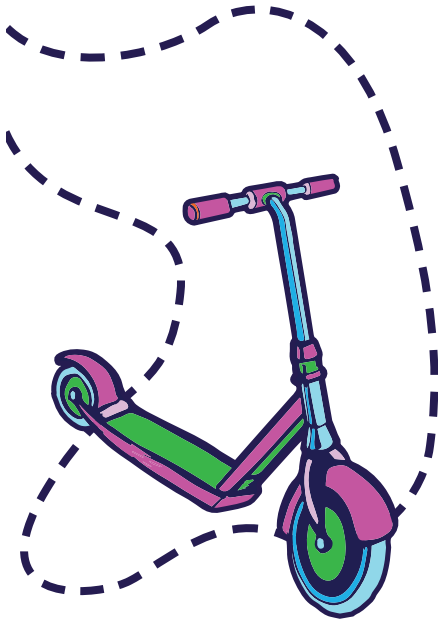

Jesus sends Ananias to help Paul regain his sight.

Weekly Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I love you, and I'm going to help you get ready for the day. I'm so glad Jesus gives us people to help us and gives us opportunities to help others."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You for all of the people you send to help us, like (name people who help you and your child)."



Drive Time

While on the go, look for helpers. Bagging groceries, tying a shoe, carrying boxes... these are some ways people help. Talk about how Jesus gives us all kinds of people to help us, just like Jesus gave Paul Ananias to help him see again.



Bath Time

Add plastic cups and large spoons to bath time. Ask your child to help you scoop the water and fill the cups. As you play together, talk about all of the people Jesus gives us to help us.

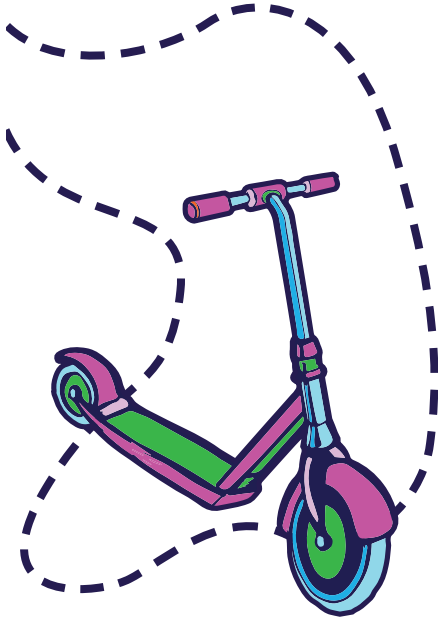

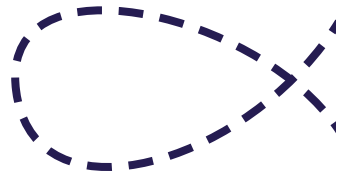
Bible Story

Peter Goes to the House of Cornelius Acts 10

Jesus teaches Peter to love everyone, so Peter tells Cornelius about Jesus. Then Cornelius brings more people to hear about Jesus too.

Weekly Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! It's time to wake up and love everyone the way Jesus loves everyone!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, please help [name of child] and me be a friend to everyone the way Jesus is a friend to everyone."



Drive Time

While on the go, talk about ways we can love everyone the way Jesus loves everyone. We can say kind words, share what we have, help people, pray for people—all of these are ways we can love like Jesus.



Bath Time

Add several toy people to bath time—super heroes, favorite characters, Little People®...whatever you have. Say, "Jesus loves everyone, and that means we can love everyone, too!" Pretend to care for all the toy people by feeding them, helping them when they are sick, making a bed for them with a wash cloth, etc. Talk about how taking care of people is one way we can love them the way Jesus loves them.

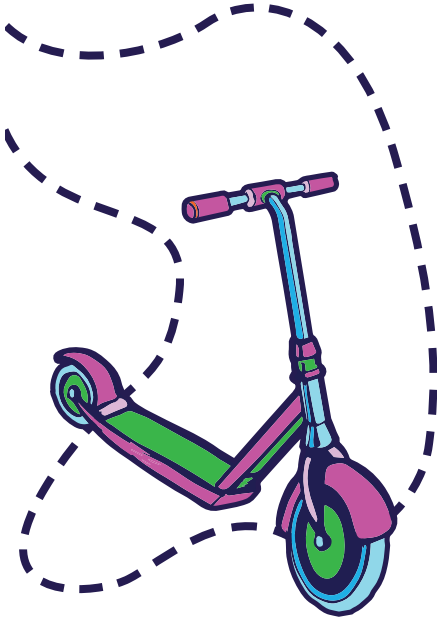


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Bible Story

Weekly Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! It's time to wake up. Follow me to breakfast the way Peter followed the angel."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, help [name of child] and me remember that Jesus is always with us and He is the best friend we will ever have."



Drive Time

While on the go, take turns naming different places your family has been to—both local and far away. Each time you name a place, ask, "Is Jesus with us at [name of place]?" Then answer with a big, "YES!" Because Jesus is always with us!



Bath Time

Add some toy cars (or any toy) to bath time. Show your child how to make them follow each other all around the tub. Talk about how Jesus wants us to follow Him and be His friend forever!



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
